

## MARAC Governance Templates (Safe Lives, 2012)

**This resource pack is included in the CTIP M&E Toolkit primarily to support CTIP practitioners and organizations seeking to develop Information Sharing Protocols.**

The resource aims to support the running of 'Multi-agency Risk Assessment Conferences / meetings' (MARACs) to support survivors of domestic abuse and includes, specifically:

- A checklist for development of a Multi-agency Information Sharing Protocol;
- A checklist for development of a Multi-agency Operating Protocol, and;
- A template job description for a MARAC administrator.

The **Introduction** provides quick support on what MARACs are; who the resource is designed for; what is included; how to use the checklists and template to support practice.

### **Section 1. MARAC Information Sharing Protocol Checklist**

This section provides step-by-step guidance for developing a multi-agency protocol for information sharing (pages 3-4). It also provides support for developing a MARAC Information Sharing Protocol (ISP), key details to include, and how to encourage adoption.

### **Section 2. MARAC Operating Protocol Checklist**

This section provides further detail on how operating procedures may vary depending on organisation and provides additional key considerations or prompts for necessary discussions (pages 5-8).

### **Section 3. MARAC Administrator Job Description**

This section provides a MARAC Administrator job description (pages 9-10) to support organisations in onboarding that role (on the basis that MARACs operate most smoothly with a designated administrator or consistent point-person for MARACs in a locality or region.)
